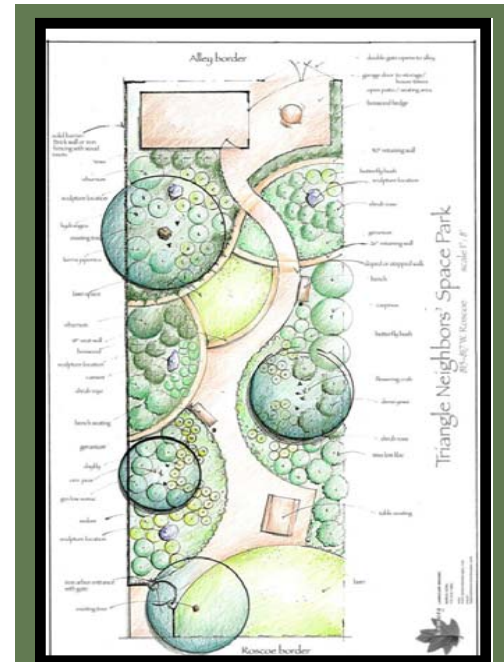

Opportunity Knocked, Help us Open the Door.

We've already purchased the two lots at a cost of over \$1.2 Million. The hard work is done - now it's time to start building our park.

The garden site is in a densely populated, congested part of Lakeview which in recent years has seen unprecedented development. This community asset will positively impact the quality of life and local property values.

Triangle Neighbors, part of Lake View Citizens' Council, worked with NeighborSpace, a non-profit "urban land trust" in Chicago, to create this garden oasis scheduled to open to the public in Summer 2008.

Escape Within Our Neighborhood

The garden park will be an environmentally friendly, beautiful and peaceful "escape" within our neighborhood. It will be a park designed *by* and *for* the community in an effort to create and preserve open spaces in our neighborhoods. Local residents will have a place to enjoy cooperative gardening and build community.

Ongoing Garden Management

The garden will be managed by the Triangle Neighbors Association in a structure similar to Wendt Play lot (nearby children's lot). The garden committee will be responsible for watering, weeding, cleaning, and otherwise maintaining the garden's appearance.

The garden will be enclosed with a brick wall and a secure, iron-fence with a gated entrance. Ornamental lighting will supplement the six large street lamps that are currently mounted around the property.
