

Letter from our Neighborhood President

What a year and so many people to thank! I begin by reflecting on this past June when we closed on the first half of community garden at 815 W Roscoe. We still need to raise an additional \$625,000 for the adjacent lot at 817 W Roscoe by June 2006 and then get the landscaping designs and planting started before next fall.

Alderman Tunney rewarded our diligent efforts to make our streets safer and cleaner. The new curbs and sewer drainage correction project for Roscoe Street is nearing completion and the two speed humps (just past the alley and at the 900 block) should go in by 12/31. Several other streets in Triangle were also done.

This year's Halloween Parade raised almost \$15,000 for the park project and was a huge success. All the local news programs covered our parade Halloween night. We also had advance featured articles in the Tribune, Sun Times, and neighborhood and gay press.

Thanks to all the sponsors and volunteers for making our fundraising efforts possible. Special thanks go to Tom LaPorte, Chicago Special Events Management, and Police Commander Gary Yamashiroya. The parade has definitely become **the** major event Halloween night in Chicago. Look for an even bigger and better production in next year's 10th Annual event.

Keep reading the Tales for details about two new events. Close to Valentine's Day, look for the Celebrity and Bachelor Auction at a local spot. We're also planning the "Duffer's Delight" golf outing at the Waveland Course in April. Let's all pitch in to make these the fun opportunities for success they offer us in building our community.

Northalsted Holiday Walk: Winter Wonderland


NAMA's 11th Annual Holiday Walk is this Saturday, December 3rd and Sunday, December 4th from Noon to 5PM each day.
