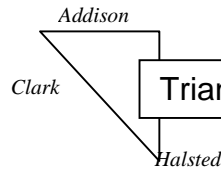

## Gay Games VII: Neighborhood Impact

The Gay Games VII are just around the corner and we want to keep you informed of any potential impact to our neighborhood.

With the exception of the Triathlon and Sailing, none of the events will take place in Lake View. The Triathlon will be held on Sunday, July 16th. Lake Shore Drive will be closed to host the running portion of the competition.

The closing ceremony of the Gay Games will be held from 3PM-5PM on Saturday, July 22nd at Wrigley Field. We've been told it may sell out with as many as 40,000 spectators and participants heading towards our neighborhood in the late afternoon.



At the last Triangle meeting, we approved having a small event at Roscoe and Halsted (closing Roscoe Westbound). We are working to obtain the necessary permits and looking for sponsors. All proceeds from the event will benefit our Space Park efforts. Tentatively we will have food/drink in a confined outdoor area and charge a cover. The goal would be to have the event from 5PM - 9PM. Watch your email in mid-July for further details.

## Space Park: The Home Stretch

Have you seen the updated thermometer sign at the future site of Space Park? We're getting close with only \$350,000 left to raise between now and December 31, 2006. Your friends and neighbors are pitching in to make sure we acquire the second, adjacent lot at 817 W Roscoe.

The GimmeSpace Golf Outing in May netted \$6,000 and was a huge success. Roscoe's Tavern & Sidewalk Café sponsored the "Boys 2 Women" night and raised an additional \$1,200 for the Park.

In the month of July, there are two local fundraisers planned physically near the park at Roscoe and Halsted and an additional event for the Real Estate Community (developers/agents).



First, we will hold our second annual "Lemonade Stand" during the Lake View Garden Walk. Stop by for some free lemonade and be sure to drop off your tax deductible check made payable to either "NeighborSpace" or "LVCC". (*The park is a stop on the trolley.*)

Then after the Closing Ceremony of the Gay Games on July 22nd, we will hold another fundraiser on Roscoe Street (see above).

The Rooftop Owners have been great supporters of our efforts. "Beyond the Ivy" has donated the use of their Rooftop located at 1048 W Waveland. We have 100 tickets for Saturday, September 2nd Cubs versus San Francisco 1:20PM Game. Your \$100 ticket purchase covers all the food and drink PLUS, if we sell out, \$10,000 goes directly to our Park.

Believe it or not, at the August 9th Triangle Neighbors' Meeting, we'll start planning the Halloween Parade, another park fundraiser.
