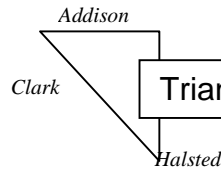

Halloween Parade

Join your neighbors at "Freak Out: Disco Gone Evil," the theme of this year's Triangle Neighbors Northalsted Halloween Parade on Tuesday, October 31st (7:30 kick-off).

Our parade-- celebrating its 10th anniversary in 2006 - will again include a costume contest with over \$5,000 in cash and prizes. Free registration at Spin (Belmont/Halsted) begins at 5:30PM. There are categories for kids, pets, adults, drag, and groups. The event is guaranteed to be one of the city's most outrageous Halloween celebrations on Halloween night, October 31 as it marches up Halsted.

The parade is free to both watch and march (advanced registration required). Several fundraising activities will run concurrently with all proceeds benefiting Space Park, an Urban Eden. Thousands are expected to either participate in or view the parade. Halsted will be closed to traffic from 6:30 - 10PM.

Judging for kids and pet winners will begin at 7:15PM. Prizes for kid and pet winners will be awarded at the beginning of the parade. On Southport Avenue, from Belmont to Bryon from 12N - 3PM.

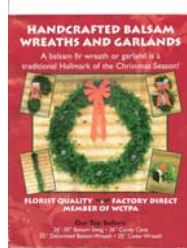
11/18 - CLMA's How Lake View Looks
